This week we are going to add colour to your creations.





GETTING STARTED

Before we start drawing I want you to think about all the colours we can see on the lion. There are lots of different tones and shades. This is when you have lighter and darker versions of the same colour.

We will be using our pencils in two different ways, heavily and softly.

Hold your pencil at a slant so it's close to your page. I like to grasp the top, as if I was picking it up. The pencil is held in a stable position between the thumb, index and middle fingers, with your index finger resting on the tip of the pencil.

It's important that you feel comfortable. Don't rush with your shading, stay on each section until it's even and smooth.

Slow and soft.

You want to achieve a tone where you can't see any harsh pencil lines.


On a scrap piece of paper, practise shading with your pencil.


TAKE YOUR TIME, DON'T RUSH





We are going to use yellow as our base colour. We will be layering our colours on top of each other to create lots of different tones and shades. The softer the better.

I have left a few areas the white of the paper. Can you see where they are?




Next get your orange and shade the areas you can see above. Again there are areas I haven't shaded.






Now get your light brown pencil. This is a little trickier to see, so have a really good look before you start. Compare the last two images closely.




After the light brown get your dark brown pencil, add extra shading on the face, and draw on top of the expression lines.



Now with your black pencil we are going to colour around the eyes (I've added extra detail, see arrows), and outline certain areas of the face.


Draw small verticle lines on the chin.




Lightly colour the nose and inner ears pink.




With your dark brown add hair lines in the directions you can see above in the mane.



Add more with orange.



Shade around the face with your dark brown.



Colour the sections of the shield in the Gryffindor colours. Outline in black.
Colour Gryffindor writing black.
